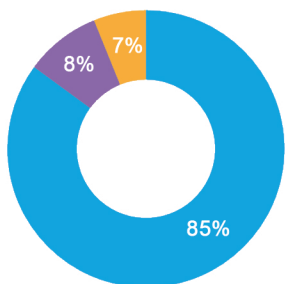

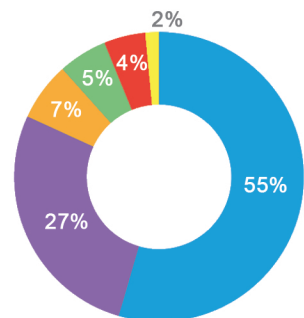

We offer a variety of programs and services to **heal children** who have been wounded by relationship trauma, **empower youth** to reach their full potential as caring adults and **strengthen families** who are struggling with parenting challenges.



HEALING children

COUNSELING services are provided to children ages 0 - 17 who have suffered from abuse, neglect or other life-changing events. CCFI's therapeutic approaches with children involve the entire family, including a child's biological, adoptive or foster parents and other caregivers.

EMPOWERING youth

BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF NORMAN at CCFI provides a safe and caring environment to Norman Public School students ages 6-18. The Club offers a variety of enrichment opportunities including:

- Programs for academic success, healthy lifestyles and character and leadership development
- Recreational activities
- Positive adult mentoring
- Family-oriented events and activities
- Educational field trips

STRENGTHENING families

THE BABY PANTRY offers families emergency baby supplies when their resources are extremely limited. Diapers and baby wipes are stocked by in-kind donations from the community and all items are provided free of charge, no questions asked.



BRINGING UP BABIES is a free, voluntary program offered to pregnant and parenting individuals, including teen parents, to create healthy and stimulating home environments for their children. In-home visits offer parent education focused on a variety of topics, such as pregnancy, early childhood literacy and overall child developmental.

DIVORCE & CO-PARENTING SERVICES aim to reduce childhood stress and strengthen parent-child relationships by offering education and guidance for parents going through a divorce, separation or guardianship case. Services include:

- 4 hour court mandated class for divorcing parents
- 8 week psychoeducational class series
- Supervised visits and exchanges

PARENTS ASSISTANCE collaborates with families referred by DHS to foster healthy, positive and trusting relationships with their children. We offer three parent education groups covering vital parenting issues such as discipline, physical safety, emotional health and the impact of trauma on children and families.
