CCFI Wins \$10,000 Innovation Grant from United Way of Norman

We are honored to have been selected as the 2024 recipient of The Launch Innovation grant from United Way of Norman! This grant will fund CCFI's new initiative called **Parent Café: Connections & Conversations**. Through these curated conversations, caregivers form connections with each other, build resiliency and grow confidence in their parenting abilities.



This project was initiated from a need that was discovered in our 2022 community needs assessment, where caregivers expressed high interest in support groups for parenting children of all ages. Community respondents indicated that this service area was missing from the Norman area, with caregivers often reporting feeling alone or having little peer support during early childhood and teen years. Having other caregivers to connect with helps individuals with their mental health and well-being, which affects the child and family as a whole.

We would like to thank United Way of Norman for this opportunity and offer our congratulations to the other amazing finalists. It's truly inspiring to see so much innovation and passion in one room!


