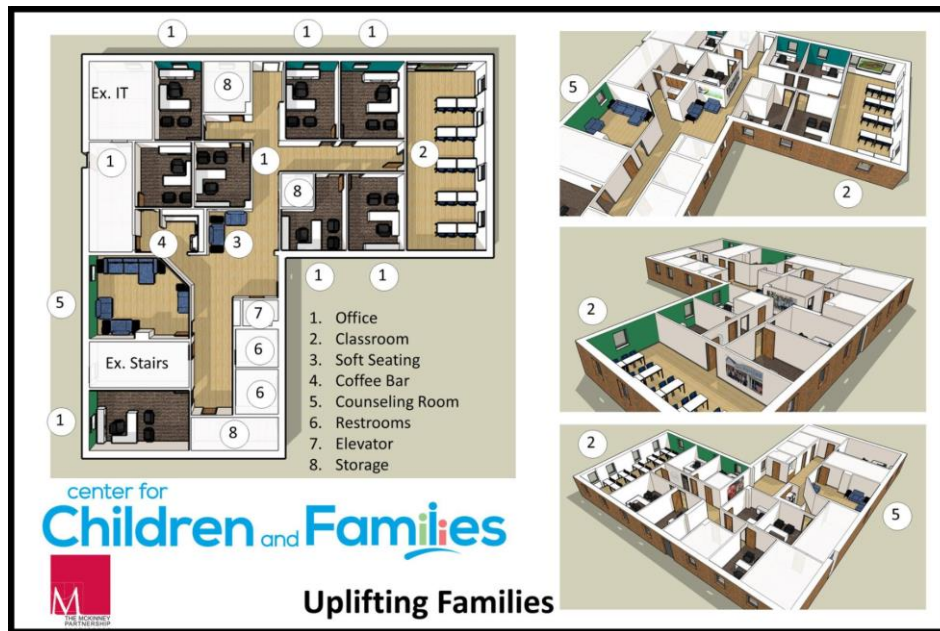
CCFI Launches Capital Campaign to Support Expansion Efforts
