CCFI Completes ARC Training Series

Earlier this month, a small team of staff members showcased their knowledge regarding Attachment, Regulation and Competency (better known as the ARC framework) with a two-day presentation. This came as the culmination of a multi-year learning collaborative with internationally recognized traumatic stress researcher and trainer, Dr. Joseph Spinazzola. The ARC framework provides a flexible, components-based intervention for children and families who have experienced complex trauma, which we hope to incorporate into our daily work.

Children in the Middle Class Expanding Virtual Options

We have expanded the virtual option for Children in the Middle to now offer ZOOM classes for individuals who live 30 miles or more from the agency location. This includes north Oklahoma City, Midwest City, Del City, Edmond and other surrounding areas.

Children in the Middle is an 8-week class series offered **free of charge** and is required for families in our mediation, supervised visit and/or exchange services. This series provides valuable skills for parents who are in high-conflict situations due to divorce, separation, or ongoing child custody issues and is designed to help parents communicate with each other and establish a functional family environment for their children. By opening up our virtual classes, we hope that those in surrounding communities can better receive the same valuable services offered locally here in Norman.
